Apple will announce its latest Macintosh operating system in the Fall of 2020.

Some Macs, however, will not be able to upgrade their operating systems to version 11.0, which is named Big Sur.

The following is a list of Macs that will be able to be upgraded to OS 11.0:

MacBook 2015 and later
MacBook Pro late 2013 and later

MacBook Air 2013 and later Mac mini 2014 and later iMac 2014 and later iMac Pro 2017 and later Mac Pro 2013 and later

All other Macintosh computers will continue to work with their existing operating systems, but will not accept OS 11.0.

A final suggestion: Back up and update your computer's files on a regular schedule. And be sure to do a backup before upgrading to the new OS 11.0.
